- Experience working for a U.S. Senator in D.C
- Gain experience sharing producer information and priorities with elected officials
- Build a network of swine industry professionals to use in career searching postgraduation

- Ability to prioritize & work resourcefully and independently
- Ability to work on several projects at the same time
- Outgoing personality with an ease to meeting new people
- Ability to work a flexible schedule including some nights and weeks

Eligibility: The internship is available to any student, but preference will be given to the following:

- An Iowa resident
- Full-time college student
- Student in good scholastic standing
- Exhibits a strong and passionate interest in agriculture, ideally the pork industry

Intern will be assigned projects & tasks overseen by the Senator's staff and IPPA staff. Activities may include, but are not limited to:

- Assist with drafting briefs or visuals for the Senator
- Attending meetings with the Senator's constituents
- Assist with the IPPA Grassroots program
- Plan & facilitate the celebrity chef & volunteer schedule o the Iowa Pork Tent at the Iowa State Fair
- Assist IPPA staff with on-going & new projects
- Communicate current industry issues, association programs & educational opportunities to producers & the next generation
- Other duties as assigned
